Flight Testing Activities Castle Kennedy Aerodrome

The Castle Kennedy Aerodrome Runway may be closed for kite flying activities as per the AIP Section ENR 5.5 – Aerial, Sporting and Recreational activities.

Use of Castle Kennedy Aerodrome is **PPR in advance only** by contacting Stair Estates

Pilots should be aware that KPS frequently flies a large kite system on the runway at the Castle Kennedy aerodrome.

When present on the aerodrome, the system comprises a large kite connected by a long tether to a stationary vehicle. All operational vehicles when present on the aerodrome are identified by high visibility flashing lights.

The maximum flying height of the kite is 120m agl.

This activity is not required to be notified by NOTAM for the West Freugh Danger Area 402A

There are no planned flight-testing activities and the aerodrome is open for use.
